## Course Description

This is an introduction to Chinese politics for students familiar with the discipline of political science. It aims to deepen participants' understanding of contemporary China reforms and current events. The main focus of the course is domestic politics. Topics covered in the class include: history and legacies that shape today's China, the political and legal systems, the functioning of these systems, the ongoing reforms, economic, legal, societal ones.
