Course Description

Men have been historically the focus of study or the 'default' for criminological inquiry. It has only been in the last several decades that women have gained the attention of criminological scholars. This course examines gender through the experiences and treatment of women in the media, the law, and the criminal justice system. The course explores the construction and treatment of gendered bodies as well as gendered forms of work, institutions and social processes. It also analyzes the gendered dimensions of central criminological processes, such as criminalization, victimization, policing and the criminal justice system.
