#### **Course Description**

The course provides a survey of Swedish literary tradition, from the Middle Ages until today. It is centered on canonized and internationally well-known authors such as Carl Michael Bellman, Carl von Linné, Selma Lagerlöf, August Strindberg, and Gunnar Ekelöf. Additionally, more popular fiction, for example Astrid Lindgren's children's books and Henning Mankell's crime novels, are examined. The course also addresses the unique Swedish tradition of proletarian literature, and special attention is devoted to women's literature and literary tradition. All texts are read in English translation. The focus is on literary history as well as on analysis and interpretation of literary texts, but also fundamental concepts of literary theory are presented.
