Course Description

This course provides a general overview of psychology. It explores various forms of human behavior, including thinking, using language, solving problems, and making decisions at the individual level, as well as forming social relationships and participating in group actions at the interpersonal level. Students not only learn about psychological theories and research, but also discover ways to apply such knowledge to their own experiences. Topics include personality, social psychology, motivation and emotion, development, perception, cognition and learning, body-mind, and mental disorders. Text: either W.
