Course Description

This course provides an analysis of the area of psychology known variously as "individual differences" or "differential psychology." The course covers several key areas of psychology that show substantial individual differences including personality, psychopathology, intelligence, and cognition. It explores the causes and effects of these individual differences drawing from research using approaches from psycho-dynamics to behavioral genetics. Students examine the evidence behind several key controversies in individual differences including the continuum between personality and mental health, the nature versus nurture debate, race differences in intelligence, and genetic determinism.
