This course introduces students to the study of constitutional law and theory, addressing a number of key doctrines and significant points of debate. The second part of the course addresses the separation of powers under the Irish Constitution, focusing on the limits of and interaction between the legislative, judicial, and executive powers of government. The third part of the course addresses the overarching issues of constitutional litigation and constitutional interpretation.
