### **Course Description**

Does income inequality lead to political polarization? Is social class related to parenting? What accounts for income inequality between ethnic groups in the labor market? We will use statistics and programming to answer these questions throughout the semester. This course focuses on applying statistics, analyzing data, and interpreting results.
