Course Description

This course introduces students to psychological processes underlying music perception, cognition, and performance. Students examine the relationship between musical phenomena and mental functions. The course covers different aspects of music perception including psychoacoustics and sound perception, music cognition including music memory, emotion and expectancies, skilled performance, and abnormalities in music perception and performance. The course consists of seminars, including student presentations. It also places emphasis on the development of critical thinking and the ability to relate conceptual debates in psychology to issues in the real world.
