## Course Description

The course provides an overview of important theoretical contributions in international macroeconomics and open macroeconomics. The course introduces recent work in international macroeconomics and finance. Topics: financial globalization; national income accounting and the balance of payments; exchange rates, portfolios, and foreign exchange markets; monetary policy, interest rate and the exchange rate; production and exchange rate in the short run; fixed versus floating exchange rates and the role of central bank interventions; and Euro and optimal currency areas.
