# **Course Description**

This course offers an introductory survey. It begins by asking why Shakespeare is still considered a writer worth studying, four hundred years after his death– and why his work tends to be given a particular prominence within English Studies. The course concludes by considering the question of how the study of Shakespeare's plays relates to theoretical issues more generally.
