The course is divided into three parts: world economy trends and developed economies; regional economy (Asian economies and the EU economy); and "along the way" and the emerging economies. The three modules respectively focus on the economic issues of the United States, Japan, Germany, Sweden, Russia and other countries, as well as the regional economies of the European Union and East Asia, and the economic issues along the "Belt and Road" of the "BRIC countries."
