Course Description

This course covers the historical evolution of regional order, evolving East Asia geopolitical landscape, China's rise, American pivot to Asia, and U.S.-China hegemonic rivalry, Japan's quest of a normal state, and the Korean equation. The course also covers the North Korean nuclear problem, Korean unification and strategic choice. The course examines the interplay of economics and community-building in East Asia. It traces historical evolution of economic transformation in East Asia focusing on China, Japan, and South Korea. It looks at patterns of cooperation and integration in the region. Other topics include U.S.-China trade friction, prospects for peace and denuclearization in Korea and the future of community-building in East Asia.
