Course Description

This course in public economics is divided into three parts. The first part discusses the problem of aggregating individual preferences, the normative criteria for efficiency and equality and their integration in the functions of well being. The second part presents an introduction to the theory of taxes, providing analysis of the incidence of taxes and their effects on behavior. The final part reviews the basics of key tax figures, fiscal decentralization, and the ideas behind the "Tax Reform." Students are expected to have completed coursework in mathematic analysis, including an introduction to constrained optimization, and intermediate microeconomics, including an introduction to general equilibrium.
