Course Description

This course introduces students to the principles, approaches, and quantitative methods of population analysis and demographic phenomena (population structures and movement, trends in mortality, fertility, and migration). Students learn how demographic dynamics are linked with socioeconomic advancement, in different regions of the world. To discuss demographic phenomena like the demographic transition, population growth and population aging, students are made familiar with demographic concepts, socio-economic theory, and descriptive statistics. The presentation of specific analytical tools for the measurement of population dynamics provides students with the ability to read the tables and the graphs that are displayed later in the course. Students are also made familiar with current empirical research results in the field of demography. Finally, students are encouraged to discuss policy implications of demographic challenges in diverse regions of the world.
