## **Course Description**

Topics include an introduction to Hebrew writing and pronunciation; basic conversational skills; gender and number: singular and plural feminine suffixes; verbs: conjugation, present tense, masculine and feminine, singular, plural, infinitive; sentence structure: forming a question; forming a simple sentence, using a plural verb without a pronoun, impersonal form; adjectives: singular and plural, masculine and feminine; pronouns: personal, singular, and plural demonstrative; the definite article; agreement of nouns and adjectives; telling time; negation in the present tense; and vocabulary.
