## Course Description

The second module covers the impact of globalization on China's overall economy, labor market, and capital market in 1978. The third module focuses on the dynamic evolution of China's urbanization process and economic geography since the reform and opening up, and discusses the economic impact of related reforms, trade, and space policy changes.
