Course Description

This course surveys Australian art from the time of white colonization to the present. It examines many of the main figures and movements that make up the history of Australian art and addresses questions raised in the writing and thinking of this art history. Topics discussed include the impact of post-modern approaches on Australian art history; the possibility of writing another, un-Australian history of Australian art; the relationship between European and indigenous art; and the existence of an identifiable (white) Australian art and culture. Students are encouraged to visit local art galleries and to familiarize themselves with the Australian works held by the Queensland Art Gallery.
