## Course Description

This course introduces students to the field of inclusive early childhood education. The course discusses early child development, as well as the process of identifying specific developmental needs in early childhood and how individuals think about targeting educational interventions for these needs. Students read and discuss theoretical material, case examples, and empirical research, and consider their implications for inclusive educational practice.
