Course Description

The course discusses environmental studies as an interdisciplinary field, exploring their intersection with other disciplines. The core of the course is focused on the current environmental issues in a global context, primarily within the conceptual framework of Anthropocene and Post-Anthropocene. The Czech context is presented through an analysis of the most burning environmental issues, including brown coal mining, air pollution, carbon emissions, waste management, landscape transportation, soil erosion, and energy production. The interconnection of social, economic, and ethical contexts of environmental issues is stressed throughout the course. The course consists of lectures, discussions, student presentations, group work, quizzes, and an excursion.
