## Course Description

This course is designed for international and local Taiwan undergraduate students. By reviewing and discussing literature, the course provides an understanding of Taiwan through its major writers and works. The course focuses on Taiwan literature of the 1990s which was a time of change. Topics range from women's experience and gender writing; individual and collective memory; city literature; and travel writing. The course entails weekly readings of selected portions of Taiwanese literature followed by in-class discussion. Assessment: class participation and preparation, short papers, and a final report.
