Topics include the process of visual perception; receptive fields and how the visual system responds to changes in light patterns; the visual cortex and how the brain processes complex visual stimuli; form perception and how people perceive the form and shape of objects; depth perception, focusing specifically on oculomotor cues, pictorial cues (monocular cues), motion produced cues, and binocular disparity; color perception and its purpose, color illusions, and contrast effects; motion perception and its purpose, movement detectors, motion after-effects (inducement of temporary visual hallucination), and animation and films; sound; touch and pain; chemical sense and multi-sensory perception (taste and smell); and illusions.
