Course Description

This course explores the system and practice of town and country planning. It covers the statutory development of planning practice in the UK, its current nature and focus, and offers an overview of the requirements for plan preparation and planning control. The course introduces planning systems, particularly in the UK but more generally across Europe, providing a context for what planning is, why we plan, how planning fits within a wider socio-economic, institutional and governmental context, and the role of the planner in society, economy and environment. The course provides students with an understanding of planning as an interlocking system of policy and political intervention amidst a range of governmental and private interests and high expectations from a range of stakeholders.
