Topics include fifth generation Chinese filmmakers; Cultural Revolution in cinema; representations of women, men, and LGBTIQ; gender politics; postmodernism and post colonialism; ambiguous identity of Taiwan cinema; Thailand in Chinese cinema; and Chinese in Hollywood movies. Assessment: class discussion (10%), film analysis (30%), midterm (30%), film festival (30%).
