## **Course Description**

This course examines the history of photography including camera obscura, silver chloride and black and white, color photography, reversal processes, roll film, 35 mm and APS, scanning and photo CDs, and digital cameras. It also explores the principles of photography including basic optics, the camera, types of camera, lenses, lighting, and introduction to Photoshop. Students participate in practical photography tutorials including the use of cameras and lenses, lighting techniques, composition, and themes. They also conduct practical photography critique digital image manipulation including communication through images, digital versus film photography, file formats, image compression, resolution and color depth, photographs and bitmaps, scanning, image correction and restoration, image manipulation, photomontage, and printing and publishing.
