Course Description

This course covers a panorama of the genres and the works of the Spanish and Hispanic-American literature of the main literary movements, linking between culture, history, and literature. The course is divided into two parts. Part 1 covers literature from Spain's Middle age to Golden Age. Part 2 covers an historical panorama of Latin-American literature, notably in Mexico and Central America. Students read a selection of poems, dialogues, plays, and extracts that reflect these eras. The course is taught in Spanish and French.
