This course is a study of international economic history of the 20th century, examining the various economic cycles experienced by the industrialized West on the whole in addition to case studies on developing nations. Topics include: instability during World War I and post-war austerity (1914-1929); the Great Depression (1929-1939), World War II and a successful reconstruction (1939-1953), the golden age of Capitalism (1953-1973), Stagflation (1973-1985), and the era of deregulation and globalization (1985-present). Developing nation case studies include: India, South Korea, Argentina, China, Sub-Saharan Africa, and Egypt and the greater Arab world.
