### **Course Description**

This course focuses on understanding and analyzing the main changes and important aspects of American culture, society, politics, and history in terms of its influence on Japanese society; therefore, some parts of the focus are on how Japanese academics have analyzed American cultural and literary topics and the assigned readings include Japanese academic writings.
