## Course Description

This course provides an introduction to topics and concepts relevant in the context of modern economic development. This course applies tools in economics in analyzing important issues in development. The emphasis in the lectures is on the methodology to study key issues in the area of development. The course discusses methods for obtaining and analyzing the kinds of data needed for the testing of theory and the evaluation of policy interventions in development contexts. The course introduces students to rigorous economic analysis in studying key issues in development economics. It introduces the distinctive environmental, technical and social characteristics of developing countries. Students examine the processes of structural and social change which occur during development; recognize the importance of institutions, technological change, international aid, and investment for the development process; and have skills necessary for the critical appraisal of theories of economic development. Prerequisites: Intermediate microeconomics, Regression analysis or basic econometrics
