Course Description

This course addresses the long sweep of European history from the First World War to the present. Alongside this consideration of the overall narrative structure of 20th-century European history, students use a broad comparative approach to analyze specific themes of overall importance and explore how they emerged within particular national trajectories. The course ranges across Europe as a whole, cutting across distinctions of East and West, North and South, and encompasses a way of approaching certain events that draws out common features across the continent over the last century.
