Course Description

The course provides students with a broad picture on the English law of contract. This course particularly focuses on leading cases of this area. However, main structure of law and major concepts are also discussed. Lecture topics include the negotiations for a contract; formation of the contract; form, consideration and intention; vitiating factors; finding the terms of the contract; controlling the content; the doctrine of privity and the reform; change of circumstances; and remedies for breach of contract. Each student is expected to read some cases before each class begins and be ready to join the discussions.
