This course provides a study of social changes and social problems. It focuses on the following aspects: evidence-based analysis of the dynamics of social change; factors contributing to social problems; proactive and reactive measures in responding to social problems; and case studies of the dynamics of social change and social problems in Thailand and other countries.
