Course Description

This course facilitates a political reading of the Gospel of Luke. It pays special attention to the theme of peace and conflict as reflected in the Gospel. A comparison is made between the gospel of Jesus Christ and the gospel of Caesar in the Jewish and Roman imperial contexts. The course draws on the historical, literary, theological, and ideological dimension of Luke's Gospel, and reconsiders the implications of biblical interpretation for today's global society struggling to fill the gaps between the language of love and hate.
