This course introduces the core and cutting-edge scholarship in urban sociology. It discusses theories and empirical studies related to the issue of social inequality, with a focus on urban politics, including the issues of food, housing, gentrification, and neighborhood change. It highlights global and transnational perspectives, with a focus on Asian cities, especially the case of South Korea. Focusing on the forces of globalization that are intricately tied to urban lives, this course examines how we connect the micro-level of our social interactions, consumption, and daily lives to macro-levels of progress, global economic forces, politics, and culture.
