### **Course Description**

This course analyzes the causes and consequences of international trade. It examines the theoretical tools necessary to understand why countries trade, which goods are traded, what are the gains from trade and who enjoys them, and why multinational corporations may arise. This course also explores the reasons why countries may have an incentive to restrict or regulate international trade and study the tools of trade policy.
