Course Description

All of us observe our social worlds and try to understand why people behave, think, and feel as they do. This course considers a number of influential theories, philosophical and empirical approaches in personality and social psychology. Key topics are examined in the scientific assessment of personality, attitudes and emotions, including an introduction to psychometric testing (e. g., validity and reliability). Specifically, the personality component covers conceptual analysis and examines critically theories from the Psychodynamic, Behaviorist, Humanist, Social Cognitive and Psychometric traditions. The Social Psychology component examines salient social constructs such as social influence, the causes of prejudice and possible reduction strategies, and explores how cognitive processes affect social judgment and behavior.
