Course Description

This course provides a study of journalistic coverage of social issues, such as migration, gender, disability, religion, ethnicity, etc., as well as best approaches and treatment. Topics covered include an introduction to social journalism, insight into the history of social journalism and its sociological grounds, different reporting techniques used in social journalism, and an approach to service journalism. The course also discusses environmental coverage, as well as civic and professional codes in relation to the treatment of information regarding vulnerable groups and individuals. Students are expected to have completed coursework in news reporting and investigative journalism. NOTE: This course is the same as COMM 121, but taught in English.
