Course Description

The course consists of lectures, activities, and field trips regarding the environmental, historical, and sociocultural facets of Taiwan. The field trips supplement the lecture content. The course explores how Taiwan's past has shaped its modern state, and the subtle ways Taiwan incorporates foreign culture with its local culture. Course topics include: agricultural history and transformation; Taiwanese folk custom, ecology and nature, the national palace museum. Field trips locations include Jinguashi and Gold Museum, Taipei Guest House and National Taiwan Museum, and Longshan Temple and Huaxi District. Cultural activities include traditional craft, calligraphy, and Chinese mask. This course requires UCEAP students to complete an additional independent research paper on a topic of their choice.
