Course Description

The course examines both conceptual and practical issues in interpersonal communication; verbal and non-verbal communication modes in two major domains: interpersonal relationships, including friendships, romantic relationships, and family communication patterns; as well as in the workplace, focusing on effective negotiation, management, and presentation skills. In each of these domains, students explore research on how communication modes vary as a function of factors such as gender, culture, and social status, as well as learning how to examine their own and others' communication styles. Assessment: midterm exam (20%), final exam (40%), tutorial assignments (30%), two short papers (5% each).
