Course Description

This seminar studies the changes that take place in the context of an "Enemy of the State" and in the practices concerned with that situation. It looks at the evolution seen in Germany and in France since World War II. It examines how the model of a succession of four waves of terrorism-anarchy, far-left with the intent of social revolution, far-right, and ethnocentric based on religious fundamentalism- is relevant to these two countries. The main sources that are analyzed in this course are from the State (justice, security services, parliament, and State Summit) in addition to actors who are persecuted for their acts of terrorism. Also reviewed are publications and media products from this era such as films, expositions, etc.
