Course Description

This is an advanced undergraduate level course on macroeconomics. The course provides understanding of basic notions of the macroeconomics, the basic analytical tools (models) for policy analysis both in the closed economy and the open economies, and considers real-world problem, such as the recent financial crisis, through the lens of these tools. Central issues considered include capital flows, international transmission of shocks, and the role of stabilization policy. Students are expected to be familiar with intermediate macroeconomic theory and with undergraduate mathematical economics.
