## Course Description

This course consists of two components: lectures on qualitative and quantitative research methods and research groups to engage in research exercises (from developing a research proposal to conducting pilot and/or main studies). The lectures provide an introductory course in research methods to equip students to conduct their research exercises. The research group meetings deal with substantive, methodological and theoretical issues related to the research proposal and offer personal supervision for research exercises.
