## Course Description

This course will start with some instruction on debating technique, and then continue to debate a series of important issues affecting the world today. The debates will be formal, with two speakers on each side and a chairperson. Students take turns to be team members. The various debate topics include the world is gradually becoming a better place; the religion of Islam is directly responsible for terrorist acts committed by Isis, Al Qaeda and other militant Islamic groups; support of Angele Merkel's policy of admitting over a million Syrian refugees into Germany and condemn of the government of Japan for taking almost none; and the banning supermarket plastic bags to defend the global environment. Students are required to read as much as possible on each topic to be prepared to participate.
