## **Course Description**

This course offers a study of the effects of mass media and rapidly changing political culture on contemporary society. Students review different cultural, social, and political theories, and explore the relationships between each. This course uses theoretical insights and analyses to explore and understand four themes in popular political culture: economy, society, environment, and conflict. The course concludes with a discussion of what the theories, analyses, and themes illustrate about popular political culture.
