## Course Description

The first part of the course deals with the general aspects of the main cognitive processes such as perception, attention, memory, thought, and reasoning, with particular reference to the theoretical models used in psychology. In the second part of the course, more applicative themes are discussed in relation to experimentation and application in an ergonomic context of some general principles of cognitive psychology. Particular attention is given to the experimental paradigms used in laboratory psychology and some of the best known experiments of cognitive psychology are analyzed. Required reading includes PSICOLOGIA by Rumiati Nicoletti and L'USABILITÀ. MODELLI E PROGETTAZIONE by Roberto Nicoletti and Claudio Vandi. Assessment is based on a final written exam.
