Course Description

This module is generally a literature review, but can also be a minor empirically oriented project. Project topics are within the area of knowledge about the structure and function of the brain, and key areas of modern cognitive psychology, such as attention, memory, language, and cognitive control, as well as emotions and social interaction. The understanding of normal function is the primary focus of the course, but clinical examples are also used, as they provide substantial illustrations of normal functioning. Furthermore, the course provides students with knowledge of relevant research methods within the area, and major emphasis is placed on the interdisciplinary nature of the subject. The teaching consists of lectures, demonstrations, laboratory exercises, and seminars.
