Course Description

This course provides an advanced evaluation of psychological knowledge on creative cognition. Students explore the core theoretical and methodological issues in the scientific study of human creativity and imagination. They develop a critical assessment of experimental studies of human innovation, including conceptual combination, category expansion, the creation of alternatives to reality in adulthood, and the role of pretence in childhood. They formulate rigorous evaluations of experimental investigations of human insight, analogy, scientific discovery, and imagery.
