Students cover a range of topics, including: basic principles of infection and immunity, social, economic and structural changes as drivers of change in infectious disease, Spanish Flu 2018 to Coronavirus 2020: successes and challenges in response to epidemics/pandemics, sexual health and sexually transmitted diseases, vector-borne infections, how climate, geography and environment affect infectious diseases in human populations, public health interventions (e.g. behavior/surveillance) to improve infection control, vaccine-preventable diseases, vaccine policy and implementation, and antibiotics and antibiotic resistance.
