The course discusses different types of environmental policy, how they work, and for what problems they are suitable. The course discusses whether and how we can put a dollar value on nature and ecosystem services. The course studies cost benefit analysis, international treaties, pollution in general, and climate change. The course takes an economic approach to global sustainability, and studies the relationship between the environment and economic growth and trade. This course takes a tour of the fields of environmental economics.
