## **Course Description**

This course aims to demonstrate the application of psychological theory to common mental and physical health problems across the lifespan; to inform students of recent advances within clinical psychology theory and practice. Students should come to appreciate common models of psychological disorders and their treatment in clinical psychology. They will recognize that clinical psychology is a rapidly evolving science incorporating cognitive, neurobiological and social psychological theories. Lecturers are clinically-active researchers and each covers a separate topic. Themes range from general psychological processes in therapeutic encounters to the neurobiological basis of disorder and use of technological advances in psychological treatment. After an introduction to all lectures and discussion of efficacy of psychological therapies, early lectures address childhood disorders, followed by adult disorders. The series also includes lectures on including intellectual disability and chronic health problems.
