## **Course Description**

This course introduces the accounting system to identify, record and communicate business transactions for an entity. It examines how these transactions affect decision making. The course looks at accounting rules and how each country has its own accounting rules and regulations. The course analyzes the new accounting rules determined by the International Accounting Standard Board (IASB). These rules are known as IFRS and are contrasted with the rules used by the major financial markets known as GAAP (Generally Accepted Accounting Principles).
